This opportunity will allow me to continue using my strengths while also growing and exploring new possibilities. ### Functional writing

Students learn how to craft professional resumes, cover letters, portfolios, and other job documents



### Interview Preparation

Students learn proper dress code, how to communicate, and representation.



### Time management

Students receive training on how to effectively set priorities, create schedules, and balance professional and personal life



### Financial Literacy

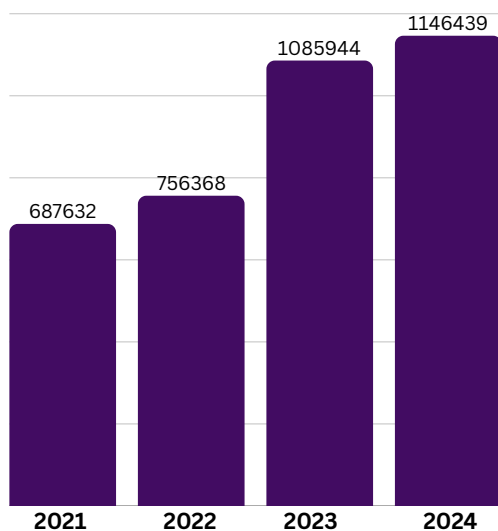

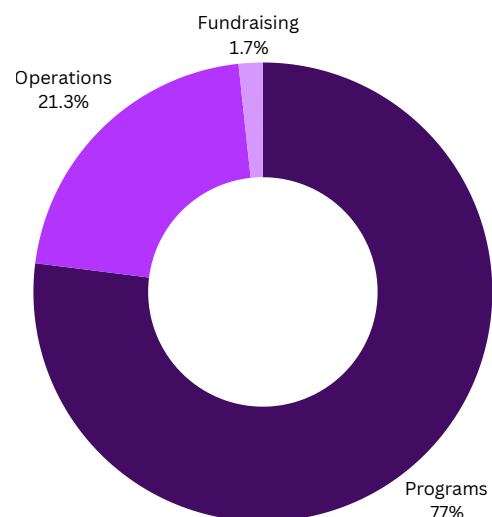
